

David Martin is the senior historic buildings officer at Archaeology South-East, University College London, a post he has held since 1992. He has been researching vernacular buildings in East Sussex (originally within the Rape of Hastings) since 1967 and (with his wife, Barbara) has written a number of papers and books on the subject, including 'Farm Buildings of the Weald, 1450-1750' (2006) and the series 'Historic Buildings in Eastern Sussex' (1997-1991). Volume 5 of the latter series was published in 1989 and concentrated on the techniques of wall construction used in houses between 1300 and 1750. David is a past president of Vernacular Architecture Group. David and Barbara are authors of "New Winchelsea Sussex: A Medieval Port Town".
