## WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A CRIME

In **emergencies** — when a crime is in progress, or there is a threat to life or property — call **999**. Do not be reluctant to call 999: the operator will assess the urgency of your call. Remember to ask for an incident number.

In an emergency, give your postcode and describe a near-by landmark (eg the church) to help the emergency services find your property. To help you remember, make a note of them here:

- My **postcode** is TN36 4.....
- The nearest **landmark** to my house is .....

For **non-emergencies** — where a crime has already taken place, the criminals have left the scene, and no one is in need of help — call **0845-60-70-999**. Remember to ask for an incident number.

To give information about a crime **anonymously**, call **0800-555-111**. Your call will not be traced.

For non-urgent local policing matters during office hours only, call **Rye Police Station** on **0845-6070-999** extension 66310. Do not call this number to report a crime.

To leave messages for the local **Police Community Support Officers** (PCSO), call **0845-6070-999**. The local PCSO's are: .....

If you come across graffiti, fly-posting, fly-tipping, vandalism or other anti-social behaviour, tell a ward parish councillor (their contact details are on the parish notice board), or your Neighbourhood Watch street co-ordinator.
